

The Frankfort, Homer Township, Manhattan, Mokena, New Lenox, and Peotone Fire Protection Districts will be accepting applications for Fulltime Firefighter/Paramedics to establish an eligibility list.

On-Line applications will be available beginning **Friday, August 20, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.** (CST). Visit www.iosolutions.com to complete the online application. Once your online application has been submitted, you will receive a confirmation number- save this number for your records.

In addition to the online application, applicants must mail/ship or hand deliver the release form, district selection page, and required documents. Documentation sent via **email will NOT be accepted.**

The Fire Protection District(s) required documents shall be received by IOS prior to the application deadline- Friday, September 3, 2021 at 5:00 PM CST. No applications or information will be accepted after this date and time. If you choose to hand deliver your documentation, please be aware that IO Solutions business hours are M- Th 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.; Fri- 8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.; closed weekends and holidays

Written Exam: The written examination will be held on **Saturday, October 2, 2021** at Lincoln Way East High School located at 201 N. Colorado Avenue in Frankfort, IL 60423. Doors open at 8:00 AM CST for sign in and you must have a valid driver’s license to sign- in. Testing will begin at 9:00 AM CST and doors will be closed- **no one will be admitted after 9:00 AM CST- NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Oral Interviews: Applicants who successfully pass the written exam will be scheduled for an oral interview with each Fire District’s Fire Commission. Dates and times of interviews will be assigned by the Fire Commissions. Failure to attend the assigned oral interview will result in the applicant not completing the testing process.

Valid and current IDPH licensed Paramedic Manhattan and Peotone FPD ONLY: Valid and current IDPH licensed Paramedic at time of hire. At time of application deadline (Friday, September 3, 2021 at 5:00 PM) applicant must be currently enrolled in an IDPH approved Paramedic program.	
Valid CPAT certification with Ladder Climb at time of application deadline AND at time of conditional offer of employment (CPAT considered valid for 12 months from issue date)
